

To: VOTE ABSENTEE

- a. Voter or voter's immediate family member may request by phone, mail, email, or fax.
- b. Elections Office to begin mailing requested absentee ballots to overseas voters 45 days prior to election.
- c. Voter may request a designee to pick up their absentee ballot on election day or up to 5 days prior to election.
- d. Designee must present own picture ID, complete an affidavit, and provide signed written authorization from the voter.
- e. 5PM, on the 6th day prior to an election is the deadline for Elections Office to receive request for an absentee ballot to be mailed to voter.
- f. Last day for Elections Office to mail the requested absentee ballot to voter is 4 days before the election.
- g. All absentee ballots must be received by the Elections Office by 7 :00 PM election day.

To: VOTE EARLY


- a. Monday – Saturday
- b. August 9 – 14, 2010 and August 16-21, 2010 (to begin 15th day prior to election)
- c. Hours: 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM daily
- d. Location: Supervisor of Elections Office 2509 Crill Ave., Ste., 900, in Palatka

To: VOTE AT THE POLLS

- (your designated polling place is on your voter information card)
- a. Polls open at 7:00 AM and close at 7:00 PM.
 - b. Anyone in line at 7:00 PM will get to vote
 - c. All voters will vote by paper ballot. Only voters with disabilities may (if they wish) vote by Touch Screen.
 - d. Instructions on voting are supplied at the polling place or you may ask any poll worker for instructions prior to entering the voting booth.

MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT, TUESDAY, AUGUST 24, 2010.

Polls open 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

Photo AND signature identifications are required by Florida law to vote – even if the poll worker knows you. (Florida Statute 101.043). Voters appearing to vote without both the photo and signature identifications will be allowed to vote a provisional ballot. The following forms of photo identification are acceptable by law: Valid Florida Driver's License; Florida ID card, Debit/credit card; U.S. Passport; Military ID; Student ID; Retirement Center ID ; Neighborhood Association ID; Public Assistance ID.

Voter's Bill of Rights

Each registered voter in this state has the right to:

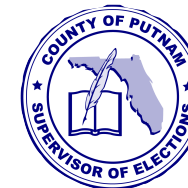
1. Vote and have his or her vote accurately counted.
2. Cast a vote if he or she is in line at the official closing of the polls in that county.
3. Ask for and receive assistance in voting.
4. Receive up to two replacement ballots if he or she makes a mistake prior to the ballot being cast.
5. An explanation if his or her registration or identity is in question.
6. If his or her registration or identity is in question, cast a provisional ballot.
7. Written instructions to use when voting, and, upon request, oral instruction in voting from elections officers.
8. Vote free from coercion or intimidation by elections officers or any other person.
9. Vote on a voting system that is in working condition and that will allow votes to be accurately cast.

Voter Responsibilities

Each Registered voter in this state should:

1. Familiarize himself or herself with the candidates and issues.
2. Maintain with the office of the supervisor of elections a current address.
3. Know the location of his or her polling place and its hours of operation.
4. Bring proper identification to the polling station.
5. Familiarize himself or herself with the operation of the voting equipment in his or her precinct.
6. Treat precinct workers with courtesy.
7. Respect the privacy of other voters.
8. Report any problems or violations of election laws to the supervisor of elections.
9. Ask questions, if needed.
10. Make sure that his or her completed ballot is correct before leaving the polling station.

NOTE TO VOTER: Failure to perform any of these responsibilities does not prohibit a voter from voting.

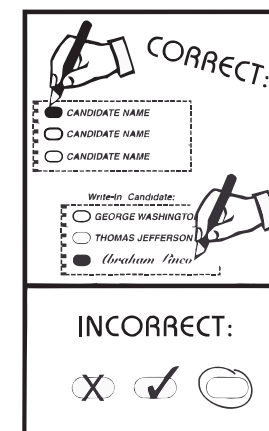
