

TEMPORARY POLITICAL SIGNS

Unincorporated Areas

Temporary political signs may be located in any zoning district provided that they are erected not more than sixty (60) days before an upcoming election, and must be removed within six (6) days following an election.

The total copy area for all political signs shall not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet of total copy area per zoning lot. No such sign shall exceed six (6) feet in height above grade.

Municipalities

As of January 1, 2011, municipalities are now prohibited from regulating when campaign signs can be posted on residential properties [Public Act 096-0904]. The new law essentially allows property owners to put up outdoor political campaign signs without any limitation on the time prior to an election.
