Will County Clerk, Nancy Schultz Voots, wishes to announce that her office will have nominating petitions available on Tuesday, September 3, 2013 for persons who wish to run in the March 18, 2014 General Primary Election.

The following countywide offices and County Board districts will be nominated for election: County Clerk, County Treasurer, County Sheriff, and Regional Superintendent of Schools (four year terms); two County Board members (four year terms) from County Board Districts 2, 5, 9 and 11. The office of Precinct Committeeman will be elected for two-year terms. Only members of the Republican and Democratic Party are eligible to run for these offices.

Nominating petitions will be available at the Will County Clerk's Office, 302 N. Chicago Street, Joliet, on Tuesday, September 3rd. You may also request a Petition Packet be mailed or e-mailed to you at <u>elections@willcountyillinois.com</u>. Petitions for federal, state and judicial offices will be available from the State Board of Elections.

The first day to file a petition is Monday, November 25, 2013. The last day is Monday, December 2, 2013 until 5:00 p.m. The Will County Clerk's Office will be closed in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday on November 28th & 29th, 2013. Petitions received by mail in the County Clerk's Office before November 25th will be returned.

Tuesday, December 10, 2013 at 9:00 a.m., is the date the County Clerk's Office will conduct a lottery for those offices where 2 or more petitions were received simultaneously for the same party as of the opening hour or within the last hour of the filing period.
