

## LEGAL NOTICE – Will County Elderly & Disabled Voters

Please be advised that the following voting aids are available to assist the elderly and disabled voters in Will County in the Consolidated Election on April 2, 2019.

---

**VOTER REGISTRATION** - Registrars are available at municipal and township offices, as well as other locations in Will County. Call the Voter Registration Department at (815) 740-4620 for more information.

The last day to register to vote **(in person or by mail)** is March 5, 2019.  
The last day to register to vote **online** is March 17, 2019.

**PERMANENTLY DISABLED VOTE BY MAIL PROGRAM** - Allows permanently disabled voters the ability to have a ballot automatically mailed to them for five years. Visit [thewillcountyclerk.com](http://thewillcountyclerk.com) to enroll.

**VOTING BY MAIL** - Request not more than 90 days or less than 5 days prior to the Election. Call the Will County Clerk's Office at (815) 740-4615 or visit our website at [thewillcountyclerk.com](http://thewillcountyclerk.com) to request a ballot be mailed to you.

**EARLY VOTING** - Early Voting is conducted at the Will County Clerk's Office located at 302 N. Chicago St., Joliet, IL 60432 as well as various locations within Will County. Visit our website at [thewillcountyclerk.com](http://thewillcountyclerk.com) or call the Will County Clerk's Office at (815) 740-4615 for more information.

**SAME DAY REGISTRATION** - Available at your Polling Place on Election Day. Voter must be able to provide two forms of identification, one of which must list the voter's current address.

**VOTING ASSISTANCE** - Elderly and disabled voters requiring assistance may be helped by a friend, relative or by two Election Judges (one from each political party) at the Polling Place. (Affidavit Required)

**CURBSIDE VOTING** - Available for voters that are physically unable to enter a Polling Place. Call the Will County Clerk's Office at (815) 740-4615 for information.

**AutoMARK VOTER ASSIST TERMINAL** - Optical scan ballot-marking technology system that allows voters to mark a ballot privately and independently. (No Affidavit Required)

**ACCESSIBLE VOTING BOOTH** - Every Polling Place will have a wheelchair accessible voting booth.

**HAND-HELD MAGNIFIER** - To view the ballot in a larger format. Located inside each voting booth.
