| <u>AutoMARK</u><br>VOTER ASSIST<br>TERMINAL  | Optical scan ballot-marking technology system that allows voters to mark a ballot privately and independently. (No Affidavit Required)  |
| ACCESSIBLE<br>VOTING BOOTH                   | Every Polling Place will have a wheelchair accessible voting booth.   |
| HAND-HELD<br>MAGNIFIER                       | To view the ballot in a larger format.  |
