Bond Proposal Question

The Board of Education of the Borough of Little Silver in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey is authorized (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades to Markham Place School and to Point Road Elementary School, including the acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment, and any site work; and (b) to appropriate \$35,930,174, and to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$35,930,174.

The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$35,080,729 (consisting of \$18,443,115 for Markham Place School and \$16,637,614 for Point Road Elementary School). The project includes \$849,445 (consisting of \$22,005 for Markham Place School and \$827,440 for Point Road Elementary School) for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this special election.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING ON THE VOTING MACHINE

1. Check in with the board worker via the poll pad.
2. Receive an authority-to-vote slip, as well as a ballot card.
3. Proceed to the voting machine. Hand your authority-to-vote slip to the board worker. Insert the ballot card, notch to the top right. The ballot will appear on the screen.
4. Make your selection by touching the screen. Tap "ACCEPT."
5. Review your selection on the summary screen. To make changes, touch the contest and make a selection.
6. Touch "PRINT BALLOT" to review printed card in the window to the right, then touch "CAST BALLOT." The card is then deposited into a secure card container for tabulation.

8. Before entering the machine, if you have any questions about voting, ask the board worker.
