OFFICIAL SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION

Proposal

Shall The Board of Education of the Borough of Shrewsbury, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey ("School District"), be authorized to: (a) undertake for lawful school purposes, a capital improvement program at the Shrewsbury Borough School consisting of (i) construction of an addition consisting of pre-kindergarten classrooms, a student resource room with options for small group instruction, and a cafeteria with storage space and adjacent restrooms fully compliant with the American Disabilities Act, (ii) replacement and/or upgrading to the electrical, communications, fire, safety, utility and HVAC systems, along with related roof repairs, and the replacement, improvement and/or repair of the windows, doors, walls and ceilings, together with the completion of exterior work and other site improvements at the facility, and (iii) the completion of such other work and improvements, and acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment as may be necessary therefor or related to the projects set forth above; (b) expend for all the foregoing an amount not to exceed \$22,517,820 (\$11,907,012 of which represents eligible costs ("Final Eligible Costs"), as determined by the Commissioner of Education); (c) issue bonds of the School District for said project in an amount not to exceed \$22,517,820, in which event the State will pay 40.00% of the debt service (principal and interest) of the school bonds issued to finance the Final Eligible Costs; and (d) transfer unexpended bond proceeds between said school facility projects. This school facilities project includes \$10,610,808 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facility efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g).

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING ON THE VOTING MACHINE

1. Check in with the board worker via the poll pad.
2. Receive an authority-to-vote slip, as well as a ballot card.
3. Proceed to the voting machine. Hand your authority-to-vote slip to the board worker. Insert the ballot card, notch to the top right. The ballot will appear on the screen.
4. Make your selection by touching the screen. Tap "ACCEPT."
5. Review your selection on the summary screen. To make changes, touch the contest and make a selection.
6. Touch "PRINT BALLOT" to review printed card in the window to the right, then touch "CAST BALLOT." The card is then deposited into a secure card container for tabulation.

8. Before entering the machine, if you have any questions about voting, ask the board worker.
