INSTRUCTIONS:
 (1) Mark only with a pen or felt tip marker having blue or black ink.
 (2) To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot fill in the oval to the left of the candidate's name like ●.
 (3) To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot write or stamp his or her name on the blank "Write-In" area under the names of the candidates for that office.
 (4) Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot.

(5) Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that public office or party position.
 (6) After marking the ballot, fold the ballot and enclose it in the envelope bearing the voters statement on the reverse side. Seal the envelope.
 (7) Sign and date the voter's statement.
 (8) Enclose the sealed envelope containing the voted ballot in the outer envelope addressed to the Board of Elections and mail immediately. The ballot of the voter must be received at the Board of Elections on or before 9:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 19, 2019 or postmarked no later than Monday, March 18, 2019.
